BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Rock Falls that the Municipal Code of the City of Rock Falls be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1. Section 32-348(a) of the Municipal Code of the City of Rock Falls is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 32-348(a). Purchase power adjustment factor.

(a) The charges to all customers under all rates for all kilowatt hours in the billing period shall be increased or decreased by a purchase cost adjustment charge or credit (PPA factor) for each \$0.0001 or major fraction thereof by which the average cost of purchased power per kilowatt hour of input to the electrical system exceeds or is less than \$0.071 per kilowatt hour. The PPA factor shall be calculated by dividing the annual purchased power costs by the annual purchased and generated (hydroelectric plant) kilowatt hours, and by multiplying the quotient times a loss factor of 1.04 and by then subtracting from the product a base power cost of \$0.071 per kilowatt hour. The PPA to be applied to all customer charges shall be determined in March of each year based upon the prior 12 month period (March through February) and shall be effective as to all meter readings and billings rendered on and after the next succeeding May 1.

The PPA factor for the period May 1, 2019 through April 30, 2020 shall be \$0.00343.

Section 2. In all other respects, Section 32-348 of the Municipal Code of the City of Rock Falls shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. All prior ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or other portion of this ordinance is held or deemed to be unconstitutional or invalid, then such holding or finding of unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption, passage and publication in pamphlet form.

WHEREAS, the City currently holds title to additional real property, all as described on the documents attached hereto labeled as Exhibit A, which Exhibit is incorporated into and made a part of this Resolution, and the real property so described has been determined by the City Council to be available and suitable for industrial or commercial development as a means of accomplishing the purposes and intent of the Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Rock Falls that:

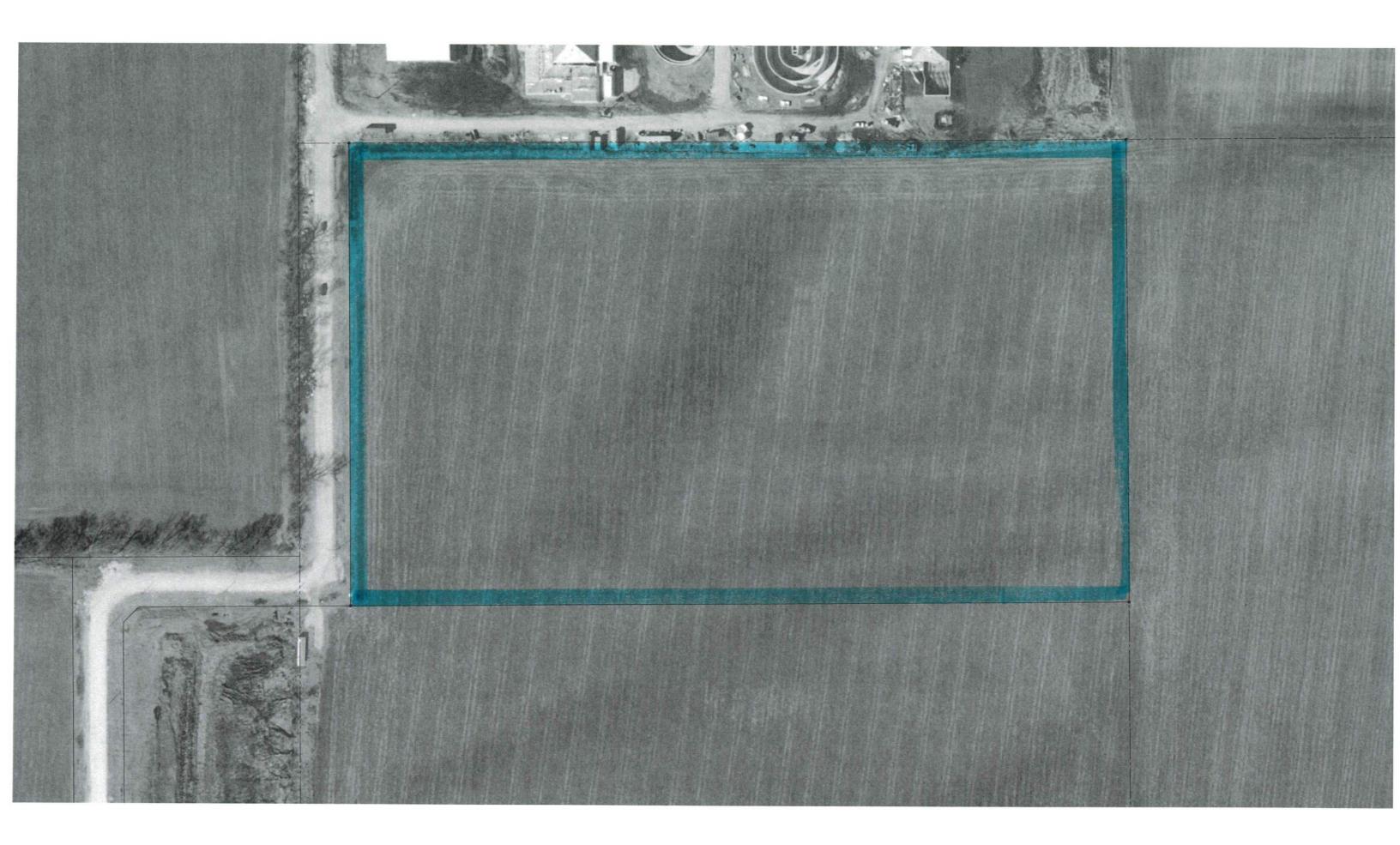
- 1. The statements set forth in the preamble hereto are true, accurate and correct and are incorporated into and a made a part of this Resolution.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF SURPLUS REAL ESTATE 711 9^{TH} AVENUE, ROCK FALLS, IL 61071

WHEREAS, the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4.2 authorizes an alternative method for the sale of surplus real property in any municipality with a population of less than 20,000 situated within a county that has had an unemployment rate, as determined by the Illinois Department of Employment Security, higher than the national unemployment average, as determined by the U.S. Department of Labor, for at least one month during the six months preceding the adoption of a resolution to sell surplus real estate; and

WHEREAS, for the month of September, 2018, the unemployment rate in Whiteside County, as determined by the Illinois Department of Employment Security, was 4.0%, which was higher than the national unemployment average for the United States of 3.7%, as determined by the United States Department of Labor; and

WHEREAS, the City of Rock Falls (the "City") has a population of less than 20,000; and

WHEREAS, on January 2, 2019, the City Council of the City of Rock Falls adopted Resolution 2019-812, which resolution authorized the sale of certain surplus real estate of the City, being more particularly described on Exhibit A, attached hereto (the "Real Estate"), by bid under 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4.1, and received no bid for the purchase of the Real Estate on such occasion; and

WHEREAS, in the event that the City has received no acceptable offer on the Real Estate within six (6) months from the adoption of the resolution, 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4.2(c) further authorizes the sale of surplus real estate by: (i) the staff of the City; (ii) listing with local licensed real estate agencies; or (iii) public auction; and

WHEREAS, a period in excess of six (6) months from the adoption of said resolution having passed, and the City receiving no acceptable offer to purchase the Real Estate, the Mayor and the City Council (collectively, the "Corporate Authorities") hereby find that the requirements of 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4.2(c) are satisfied; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Rock Falls, Whiteside County, Illinois as follows:

SECTION 1: The preambles to this resolution are true and correct and are hereby incorporated in this Section 1 as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2: The Corporate Authorities of the City hereby declare and find that the Real Estate is no longer necessary or appropriate for the uses of the City, and that the sale of the Real Estate is in the best interests of the City.

- **SECTION 3**: The terms of the sale, a legal description of the Real Estate, and its current size, use and zoning are set forth on Exhibit A attached hereto.
- **SECTION 4**: The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish this resolution upon passage once a week for three (3) successive weeks in a daily or weekly newspaper published in Whiteside County. No sale shall be conducted until at least thirty (30) days after first publication.
- **SECTION 5**: Offers or bids may be submitted to Mark Searing, City of Rock Falls Building Official, at 603 West 10th Street, Rock Falls, IL 61071, who is further authorized to solicit offers or bids for the purchase of the Real Estate on behalf of the City, and is directed to submit any such offers or bids to the Corporate Authorities for review and consideration.
