ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE ROCK FALLS MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO MINIMUM GROUND FLOOR AREA FOR DWELLINGS

WHEREAS, Section 11-13-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-1-1 et. seq. (the "Code") authorizes each municipality to exercise certain zoning powers within the territorial limits of such municipality; and

WHEREAS, Section 11-13-14 of the Code permits the corporate authorities of each municipality to amend its zoning ordinances following public notice and a hearing on said proposed changes; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council (collectively, the "Corporate Authorities") of the City of Rock Falls (the "City") have discussed the needs of the City with respect to reducing the minimum ground floor area requirements established by the zoning ordinance of the City, to permit the construction of compact residential dwellings, sometimes referred to as "tiny homes"; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have referred to the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Rock Falls the consideration to amend the City's zoning ordinance with respect to such minimum ground floor area requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Rock Falls held a public hearing on <u>August 10</u>, 2023, to discuss the reduction of said minimum ground floor area requirements within the City; and

WHEREAS, public notice of the time and place of such public hearing was given not more than thirty (30) nor less than fifteen (15) days prior to said hearing by publishing notice at least once in a newspaper with a general circulation within the City; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Rock Falls have voted to recommend to the City Council the adoption of an ordinance reducing the minimum ground floor area requirements for dwellings from 800 square feet to 400 square feet; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have considered the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission and deem it in the best interests of the City and its residents to adopt the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission and amend the City zoning ordinance to provide for the construction of dwelling units containing no less than 400 square feet of usable ground floor area within the City of Rock Falls; and

WHEREAS, in connection therewith, the Corporate Authorities of the City have determined it in the best interests of the City and its residents to amend Chapter 34, Article III, Section 34-94 of the Rock Falls Municipal Code, all as more specifically set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Rock Falls, Whiteside County, Illinois as follows:

SECTION 1: The City hereby finds that all of the recitals contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are true and correct and does incorporate them into this Ordinance by this reference.

SECTION 2: Chapter 34, Article III, Section 34-94 of the Rock Falls Municipal Code, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 34-94. – Minimum ground floor area for dwellings.

A dwelling shall contain not less than 400 square feet of usable ground floor area, exclusive of open porches, garages or steps."

SECTION 3: In all other respects, Chapter 34, Article III of the Rock Falls Municipal Code shall remain in full force and effect as previously adopted and/or amended.

SECTION 4: The provisions and sections of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be separable and the invalidity of any portion of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of the remainder.

SECTION 5: The City Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and approval and publication as required by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 2023–2614

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 32 OF THE ROCK FALLS MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO UTILITY CHARGES IN ARREARS

WHEREAS, Sections 11-117-1 and 11-150-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/1-1-1 et. seq.) generally authorize any municipality to acquire, construct, own and operate within the corporate limits of the municipality any public utility the product of which is to be supplied to its inhabitants, including but not limited to waterworks, sewer systems and electric power; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the foregoing, the City of Rock Falls (the "City") owns and operates its own waterworks, sewer system and electrical distribution system for the purpose of providing water, sewer and electric services to the residents and businesses of the City; and

WHEREAS, Section 11-117-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code expressly authorizes the City to make all needful rules and regulations in relation to the operation of its utilities; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council (collectively, the "Corporate Authorities") have determined it in the best interests of the City and its residents to amend the provisions of the City Code as it relates to applications for new utility services provided by the City, all as more specifically set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Rock Falls, Whiteside County, Illinois as follows:

SECTION 1: The City hereby finds that all of the recitals contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are true and correct and does incorporate them into this Ordinance by this reference.

SECTION 2: Chapter 32, Article II, Section 32-21 of the Rock Falls Municipal Code, as amended, shall be further amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 32-21. - No new service for arrearages.

Upon any application for service, no property upon which utility charges are in arrears and a lien for such unpaid utility charges has been filed by the city pursuant to applicable law, or any person owing utility charges and moving to other premises where there are city utility connections or where connections shall afterwards be made, shall be served until such charges in arrears are paid in full."

SECTION 3: Chapter 32, Article III of the Rock Falls Municipal Code, as amended, shall be further amended to include the addition of a new Section 32-66 entitled "Persons changing premises must pay charges and arrears" to read as follows:

"Sec. 32-66. –Persons changing premises must pay charges and arrears.

No person owing water charges including for the costs of replacement or repairs, and moving to other premises where there are connections to the waterworks system or where connections shall afterwards be made, shall be served until such charges and arrears are paid in full."

SECTION 4: Chapter 32, Article V, Section 32-193(b) of the Rock Falls Municipal Code, as amended, shall be further amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 32-193. – Sewerage connections property of city; persons changing premises must pay charges and arrears; inspection fee.

- ...
- (b) No person owing sewerage charges including for the costs of cleaning, replacement or repairs, and removing to other premises where there are connections to the sewer system or where connections shall afterwards be made, shall be served until such charges and arrears are paid in full."

SECTION 5: In all other respects, Chapter 32 of the Rock Falls Municipal Code shall remain in full force and effect as previously adopted and/or amended.

SECTION 6: The provisions and sections of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be separable and the invalidity of any portion of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of the remainder.

SECTION 7: The City Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

SECTION 8: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval and publication as required by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 2023–2615

ORDINANCE APPROVING LICENSE FOR USE OF RIGHT OF WAY (1706 14TH AVENUE)

WHEREAS, Kenneth M. Hodge and Judy A. Hodge ("Owner") are the owners of certain real property located at 1706 14th Avenue, Rock Falls, IL 61071 (the "Benefitted Property"); and

WHEREAS, the Benefitted Property is improved with a residence and is currently serviced by a private sanitary septic system; and

WHEREAS, Owner desires to abandon said private sanitary septic system and connect to the sewer system of the City; and

WHEREAS, the nearest connection to the sewer mains of the City is located approximately one hundred fifty feet (150') to the north of the Benefitted Property along the right of way to the west side of 14th Avenue at its intersection with 17th Street; and

WHEREAS, Owner has represented that it is unable to connect to the City sewer mains unless a lateral is installed within the right of way owned and maintained by the City on the west side of 14th Avenue; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 11-80-7 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/1-1-1 et. seq.) the City has the authority to regulate the openings in streets and other municipal property for the laying, building, repairing, and removing of sewers; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have considered the request and have determined that it is in the best interests of the City to allow the installation of said lateral piping within the right of way on the west side of 14th Avenue, to permit for the connection of the Benefitted Property to the sewer system of the City, all upon the terms and conditions set forth in that certain Agreement and License for Use of Public Right of Way, attached hereto as <u>Exhibit A</u> (the "License Agreement") and as more particularly set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Rock Falls, as follows:

SECTION 1: The Mayor and the City Council hereby find that the recitals above are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2: The License Agreement is hereby approved and the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute said License Agreement on behalf of the City.

SECTION 3: The provisions and sections of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be separable, and the invalidity of any portion of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of the remainder.

SECTION 4: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

SECTION 5: The City Council finds that the customary practice of requiring a first and second reading of ordinances is not applicable or necessary in the case of this Ordinance, and a first reading preliminary to adoption hereof is hereby waived, and this Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage.

SECTION 6: The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

SECTION 7: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval, and publication as required by law.
