- "Sec. 2-271. Appointment, term of office, other terms and conditions of employment.
- (a) Appointment; term of office. The city administrator shall be appointed by the mayor with the advice and consent of the city council by a majority vote. The city administrator need not be a resident of the city."
- **SECTION 3**: In all other respects, Chapter 2, Article VII, Section 2-271 of the Rock Falls Municipal Code shall remain in full force and effect as previously adopted and/or amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Rock Falls, Whiteside County, Illinois as follows:

SECTION 1: The City hereby finds that all of the recitals contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are true and correct and does incorporate them into this Ordinance by this reference.

SECTION 2: Chapter 6, Article III, Section 6-154(3)(a)(4) of the Rock Falls Municipal Code, as amended, shall be further amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 6-154. – Architectural guidelines.

- (3) Building materials.
 - a. Multifamily residential and commercial structures.

4. Metal or steel used as a construction material for external siding for building elevations shall not be permitted without the express approval of the building committee. The use of metal/steel for roofing material is permissible and may be approved by the building committee based upon context and overall site design."

SECTION 3: In all other respects, Chapter 6, Article III of the Rock Falls Municipal Code shall remain in full force and effect as previously adopted and/or amended.

SECTION 4: The provisions and sections of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be separable and the invalidity of any portion of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of the remainder.

Proposals for your Celetti Parking Lot Construction project were opened at City Hall at 10:00 A.M. on Thursday August 31, 2023. A total of four (4) proposals were received.

All proposals were opened, and the total amount bid by each contractor was read aloud. A tabulation of bids was later completed and verified in our office and is attached for your review.

BIDDING IRREGULARITIES

Porter Brothers Construction had a multiplication error in their bid which resulted in a reduction of the total amount read of \$1.38. This did not affect the results of the bidding and we recommend this irregularity be waived.

COST

The cost estimate based on completed plans was \$56,589.20. The low bid of \$63,206.22 was \$6,617.02 and 11.7% over our estimate. A tabulation of bids compared to our estimate in dollars and percent is as follows:
