4. Committee Member items	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Mayor Blanton reported on vandalism to the storage room door at the Veterans Memorial Park. It is suggested that doors on the facility have dead bolts only placed back on the doors. It was also discussed that, when organizations utilize the facility for storage, the City needs to be made aware; as otherwise, no contents are listed under the insurance coverage and in the case of a theft, no recovery can be made.</li> <li>Mayor Blanton requested that the main entrance into the Municipal Administration Building be looked at and possibly updates. Specifically, the tile wall that is viewed upon entering the building could undergo some modernization, to include directional signage about various offices and meeting rooms.</li> <li>Ald. Snow and Ald. Reitzel requested that AAA Concrete which is responsible for the sidewalks, be contacted and the status of those walkways on West 2<sup>nd</sup> Street that were due to be repaired between 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue and the High School be assessed.</li> <li>Ald. Snow reported on an item previously on the committee's agenda, "Movie Night". Following discussions with Mike Sterba, Coloma Park District and Doug Wiersema, Chamber of Commerce there is a strong feeling of support present to proceed with this venture. An ad hoc committee of Mike Sterba, Doug Wiersema, Todd Gillette, Ald, Schuneman and Ald.
