5. City Engineer, Brian Frickenstein a) Update of W. 3 rd Street Project	 Brian reported on project. Project is moving along nicely, and project is currently on schedule for the end of July. Committee thanked Brian for report. Brian reported that a cast in place wall will have to be replaced, which will cost \$7000+ as a change order. 	Change order would be sent to the City Council under the consent agenda for the next meeting.

5. City Engineer, Brian Frickenstein b) Discussion on planning for 7 th Avenue 2010	 Committee discussed how the project would be paid for under the 2010-2011 fiscal year. Would the project be funded under the MFT fund or the ½ cent fund? Committee started discussing entire road program, and potentially changing what is on the 2010-2011 schedules. Committee directed City Engineer to update prices, and requested that the City Administrator reformat list to not include years but instead having a master list. 	City Engineer will update costs for 7 th Avenue and other projects originally slated for the 2010-2011 year.
6. Committee Member Items a) Section 9-165 (b) - Mr. Reitzel	 Alderman Reitzel addressed committee about this ordinance. He was concerned that semi-trucks are parking downtown. Alderman Reitzel was told that the Police Chief was concerned about towing. Alderman Reitzel requested that Mayor speak with Police Chief regarding issue, Mayor said he would speak with Police Chief on Monday regarding issue. Alderman Reitzel requested that Mayor also speak with Police Chief about compact car parking downtown. 	Items would be addressed by Mayor on Monday.
7. Water - Mr. Padilla	 Mayor presented information from the Water department regarding creation of new water well in the next couple of years. Committee agreed with concept presented. Mayor presented information regarding the Water & Sewer design on the Reliant site that is being worked on by the design consultants for the Reliant site. Committee thanked Mayor for report. Mayor reported about some new possible projects, currently there is some interest on expanding services but nothing to report at this time. 	Committee thanked Mayor for report.
8. Street - Mr. White	 Jim White reported that he had received prices for the parking lot signs. Mayor has them now. 36" by 18" tall signs, which would sit on wooden poles would be \$2833 for 10 signs. Prices for parking lot signs which would be enclosed \$6674, and Turnroth sign would do everything. Funding for this project would come from Public Property-Municipal Signage 10-12-5425 and would be placed on the next City Council Agenda for approval. Jim questioned about E 17th Street. Project is on hold until IEPA grants a permit to the project. It is unknown when this project will start up again. Mayor requested that the Street department remove the Welcome to Rock Falls "fireplace" at Route 30 & Route 40. Jim said he would look into it when he returns.
