New Business: a) Sewer Revenues	• Trends in the Sewer Revenues indicate that previous projections have been higher than the actual return on accounts' receivable for last year as well as the first two (2) months of the current fiscal year. After listening to the presentation by Mr. Cox, the committee requested that he assemble expense data to present at the next meeting of the committee. By reviewing the revenues, as well as, the expense they will be better able to evaluate the projections.
