2. New business a) Correspondence 702 1 st Avenue- Mr. Ismet Akiti	• Committee reviewed a letter from Mr. Akiti in regards to a lien that the City has on his property at 702 1 st Avenue. The City had taken action in the past to condemn a residence at that location. Demolition was completed, and a lien was placed against all properties owned by Mr. Akiti in the amount of \$15,509.80. Mr. Akiti in his letter, request the City accept a payment of \$5,000 and in turn provide to him a full release of any obligation for the demolition cost and attorney's fees.
