Charitable Solicitations	• Clerk Wescott instituted a discussion in regards to the bucket Brigades held annually upon 1 <sup>st</sup> Avenue (Route 40) and 2 <sup>nd</sup> Street & 12 <sup>th</sup> Avenue and 2 <sup>nd</sup> Street. Although clear and well defined requirements concerning the safety of those participating are included in the language; numerous complaints, requiring intervention by our Police occur on a regular basis. 1 <sup>st</sup> Avenue has over 21.000 vehicles a day that travel upon it, and with the addition and expansion of the Health Department at 12 <sup>th</sup> Ave. & 2 <sup>nd</sup> St., both intersections are very busy, making persons in the roadway collecting at high risk for injury. In addition, with the Reliant Property project set for this spring and next years 1 <sup>st</sup> Avenue Bridge project, he requests that the bucket brigades be stricken fro Div. 4 Charitable Solicitations, Sec. 8-866 and Sec. 8-870 permanently.
