Although clear and well defined requirements concerning the safety of those participating are included in the language; numerous complaints, requiring intervention by our Police occur on a regular basis. 1st Avenue has over 21,000 vehicles a day that travel upon it, and with the addition and expansion of the Health Department at 12th Ave. & 2nd St., both intersections are very busy, making persons in the roadway collecting at high risk for injury. In addition, with the Reliant Property project set for this spring and next years 1st Avenue Bridge project, he requests that the bucket brigades be stricken fro Div. 4 Charitable Solicitations, Sec. 8-866 and Sec. 8-870 permanently.
