The signs were similar to the information kiosks found in the area of the locks off E. 2<sup>nd</sup> Street along the Feeder Canal. Still investigating on style of signage to identify the overhead crossing along the Feeder Canal pathway within the city limits. Estimated 6 or 7 overheads with one sign coming from each direction making the total to consider funding 12 or 14. Locations are: Dixon Aveenue; RR Bridge; E. 11<sup>th</sup> Street; US Rte 30; IL Rte 40; I 88; Buell Road.</li> </ul>	No Action taken
