| Discussion of the contract with the owner of 812 Ave. A | Adm. Searing presented a letter from Richard Finnicum explaining that he is unable to fulfill his obligations as presented in the contract for rehabilitation of 812 Ave. A. He is expressing his desire to have a 3 rd party assume responsibility for the property, and have it up to code in 6 months. In the letter, Mr. Finnicum states that this would be at no expense to the city. The committee decided that there is 2 options. The city can either take this offer from Mr. Finnicum, or proceed with litigation, and a re-bid process. Attorney Tom Sanders estimates the legal work thus far, as well as the necessary work to construct an instrument of assignment would cost the city approximately \$2500.
