This letter is to notify you that your City of Rock Falls Business License for a public garage has not been approved due to noncompliance with the City of Rock Falls City Ordinance Sec. 16-261(b) Garages, motor fuel stations and carwashes. Outside storage of Miscellaneous equipment (Tires) is not allowed under the City of Rock Falls Ordinance.

This letter will serve as your notice to remove the outside storage of tires within 7 days of this notice. If compliance is not achieved within the 7 days of this notice, your City License will not be issued and operation of your garage must cease.

## Sec. 16-261. Garages, motor fuel stations and car washes.

- (a) No building, structure or premises shall be used, erected or altered which is intended or designed to be used as a public garage, automobile repair shop, motor fuel station or car wash having an entrance or exit for vehicles in the same block-front and within two hundred (200) feet of any school, public playground, hospital, public library or institution for dependents or for children, and no such entrances or exit shall be located within the same block-front and within twenty (20) feet of any R district, nor shall any part of such public garage, automobile repair shop, motor fuel station or cash wash be located within one hundred (100) feet of any building or grounds of any of the aforesaid public or institutional uses.
- (b) All activities incidental to the sale of gasoline or oil such as battery and tire repair, car washing and greasing shall be conducted within the building and there shall be no storage or accumulation of miscellaneous equipment, machinery or motor vehicles, disabled or otherwise, outside of the principal structure.
