1.Call to Order @ 5:30 p.m. – Chairman Watts	Meeting was called to order	Meeting begins at 5:30pm	
2.Audience Requests a. Brian Burke – Security Camera Discussion	Brian Burke of 1112 West 6 <sup>th</sup> St. approached the committee concerning a security camera which is pointed at his property. He stated that the City has no ordinances regulating the placement of security camera to keep the privacy of others. Adm. Blackert stated that this issue has been discussed in meetings that she has attended. On public property a sign is required to inform people of the cameras.	Adm.
