3.Approve Minutes – Hennepin Canal Committee August 11th, 2016	Minutes were reviewed by the committee	Minutes approved
4. Old Business: a.Location markers along the canal.	Deputy Chief Milby presented a quote for the canal markers. The cost for 20 markers, and the driver to install them will cost \$573.76. There was some question about the markers being a life-safety item by the Fire Chief. The INDR has given approval for the installation of the markers. The Fire Department will install the markers.	The markers will be ordered by the Fire Department
b.Tree removal from the prairie under ComEd ROW.	Mr. Spinka would like to schedule the tree cutting for late October. Larry will coordinate this project with the other department heads to get the manpower for the project. The trees will be cut and treated with Tordon.	No action
5.New Business a.Grant writing discussion.	City Administrator Robbin Blackert informed the Committee that the State may be funding the recreational trails grant. The grant is \$150,000 for projects not to exceed \$250,000. The Committee discussed priorities for the parts of the trail that may qualify for the grant. Some money will need to be spent on engineering to attain cost estimates for the grant applications. Any parking lot would be costly, as it would need to be reinforced for bus traffic. The Committee would like to see a bituminous surface extending from McNeil Road to 5th Street as a first priority for the grants application. Crossings and entrances will need to be ADA compliant. The next priority is lighting and cameras along the trail. A parking lot, and benches are another priority. It may be possible to use old poles with new heads for lighting along the trail.	Adm. Blackert will speak with the City Engineers to get cost estimates for the projects.
6.RRDA Report	Eric Arduini informed the committee that the last RRDA meeting for the year will be held at the Upper Dam overlook on September 19 th at 7:00pm. Deputy Chief Milby reported that the buoys will be removed around the 28 th of the month.	No action
7.Volunteerism Report	Mr. Brian Tribley reported that his group has been keeping up with graffiti, and recently replaced one of the pexi-glass covers. Tourism Director Janell Loos reported to the committee that volunteer help is needed for the Hennepin Hundred event. There are 28 aid / food stations along the run. Stops 1-6 will need assistance in delivering supplies to them. Helpers will need to follow the truck to move food and water to the stations.	No action
8.Committee Member Items	Tim Keller reported that he has been working with boy scouts collecting milkweed pods. He will be expanding the prairie plat at the mouth of the feeder canal.	No action
