Topic	Discussion	Plan of Action
1.Call to order - Chairman Reitzel	Meeting was called to order at 8:15am	Meeting begins at 8:15am
2.West 2nd Street sidewalk safety issues.	It was explained that a pedestrian tripped in one of the holes left from tree removal. Firehouse of God ministries have now filled the area in with bricks	Barricades will need to remain on the bricks until a permanent solution is agreed upon.
3.Finished road surface for Galt Avenue and 8th Avenue discussion	Water Superintendent Ted Padilla asked for clarification on the scope of the road repairs to Galt Avenue and 8 th Avenue after his water main replacement project. Since the street is not going to be rebuilt immediately after the project as was done on 7 th Avenue. The Water Dept. will use flowable fill and patch as per ordinance.	No action
4.Finalize road list	The committee reviewed the list of roads, and the description of type of repairs to be done to each one. There was much discussion about tilling roads prior to sealcoating, and much discussion about the amount of oil used. Mr. Spinka did point out that two of the roads this year are scheduled for a single slag coat.	The Committee finalized the list of projects. Mr. Spinka will monitor oil saturation as the projects are done. Mr. Spinka will call county and get times coordinated. If needed the rototill bid will be posted.
5.Finalize sidewalk list	The committee examined the lists for concrete work and narrowed the work to be done to \$62,000. They also discussed mudjacking to be done on the west side of the High School. The Committee would like to see more enforcement of vehicles parking on sidewalks and curbs.	Committee finalized the list of projects. Contractors will be notified of the projects, and the City will work with Nicor on the sidewalks that need to be repaired due to their work.
6.Committee Member Items	Alderman Reitzel inquired about the dumping at the former PA site. Adm. Blackert stated that as soon as the ground is hard enough for truck traffic, it will be moved to the Sewer Department.	No action
