Diane will work with the new Tourism Director to get the ad for Rock Falls together along with a featured article on the Sculpture Park in the 2019 Visitor Guide.  The Governor's Conference on Tourism will be held the first weekend of February. With a new Governor, a new Illinois State Tourism Director may be appointed.	No action
E.New Business a.Review of Event Expenses	Michelle Conklin and Nikki Arduini put together expense sheets for the major events of 2018. The Committee reviewed each event and discussed the expenses and the assets that were one time purchases. There will need to be better communication in the future. Food Truck Friday's billing needs to be executed better next year. Events will not be using the City to pass through donations and purchases.  The Catfish tournament, being the first one on our own, came in costing less this year than in previous years.
