

Engineer's Report – Brian Frickenstein, WHA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Mr. Frickenstein spoke to the recent notice received in regards to a bridge project on the West Route 30 Bridge over the Hennepin Canal just south of Centennial Par. The bridge is scheduled for major repairs sometime in 2020. In anticipation of that work and subsequent bridge closure for an undetermined amount of time, alternate detour routes are being identified by IDOT to facilitate the project. One detour will cause a reduction in certain weight classifications over the City of Rock Falls East 11st Bridge.</li> </ul> <p>Following an inspection of the East 11<sup>th</sup> Street Bridge, IDPOT has advised that effective immediately the bridge needs to be posted with allowable Weight Limit Restrictions. This will require visible signage identifying single vehicle restricts of 28 Tons and Combination Vehicle restriction of 38 Tons.</p> <p>In addition, Mayor Wescott will draft a letter and send it out to all of the Business in the Industrial park, to make them aware of the Bridge posting, so that they can plan accordingly for truck traffic to there facilities, as well as, detour routes that will be needed next year during construction.</p>	Mr. Frickenstein will work with Mr. Spinka and having the proper signage made and posted accordingly.
