4. New Business (a). FY 2021 Tax Levy – Tax Year 2020 Payable 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Adm. Blackert brought forth the FY 2021 Tax Levy for the consideration of the Finance Committee. The two proposals presented were 4.99% rate and the second 7.59%. In the 4.99% proposal, we will use reserves in Tort, Social Security and W/C to cover the projected cost for those three (3) lines items, and still be able to facilitate our 90% obligation to the Police/Fire pension funds. With the 7.59% rate, we would not use reserves in those line items and seek the full projected cost. The 90% level of funding for Police/Fire Pensions will also be met. In both proposals we are putting the new Firetruck payment of \$57,272.30 on the levy, however, that dollar amount does not by state statute get incorporated into the levy configurations. Following a discussion, Motion: Kleckler, second: Palmer to send the 4.99% rate hike to the Council, which will not require a Tax Hearing. Vote: Palmer, Kleckler, Babel (Yes)= Wagelin (No) 3-1 motion carries, item to be sent to Council 	Send FY 2021 Tax Levy to Council for required action.
