Brian's replacement, Corey Buck, has been with Willett Hofmann for 27 years. Corey was introduced to all that were present. b. An Emergency call was received from the Sewer Department Head, Ed Cox, in regard to West 2nd & 12th Avenue. 180 foot of line is plugged with concrete and could potentially cause a sink hole. Civil Constructors will be contracted. Signs will be posted Monday for road closures and the project will start on Tuesday. c. Big Dig - NICOR and AT & T are done with relocation. Still waiting on a date from Comcast, should be 2nd part of August. d. Striping project is complete. e. Micro Building - Will need estimates from 2 contractors for the grant application. Terracon submitted a bid to do the soil sample and it was approved by City Council. There is a 2-million-dollar cap on the grant. f. 3rd Avenue/Fast Track Grant - Still not an announcement on who will receive it. g. Dixon Avenue - No updates

The project will be completed during 2022-2023 construction season. The grant is on an 80/20 payment structure. The City can use MFT & ½ cent money for their portion. A suggestion was made to make the entrance to Wolf Creek Road a no parking zone.
