

A motion was made by Alderman Wangelin to demolish the property at 213 Stanley Court, second by Member King, motion carried. • B. 1906 13th Avenue - City should have ownership of property any day. Inspector Searing stated that he won't know if demolition is necessary until he can make entrance into the house. A motion was made by Alderwoman Sobottka to allow Inspector Searing to determine if demolition is necessary of 1906 13th Avenue and if it is necessary that Searing should put both 213 Stanley Court & 1906 13th Avenue out on same bid, second by Alderman Wangelin, motion carried. • C. 1209 W 16th Street - Property is currently under 90 court order for cleanup. If property owner does not comply, City will be forced to complete the cleanup. • D. 1101 1st Avenue - Property was not demolished in the agreed to timeframe to lessen the amount of fines currently imposed on the property owner. Property is currently under contract for sale to a local developer.
