1. Call to Order	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Alderman Wangelin called the meeting to order with a quorum present at 8:15 a.m.</li> </ul>	
2. New Business	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Steve Moring from Moring Disposal addressed the Committee regarding the City of Rock Falls restarting the recycling program. He stated that the charges for recycling have decreased and if the City starts up the program it would be an additional \$0.30 per household. The main problem with the recycling in Rock Falls is the contamination of the recyclables. Administrator Blackert stated that we will run a training campaign before we start up the program and hopefully it will be much better. A motion was made by Alderman McKanna; second by Alderman Wangelin to allow the Mayor to sign an addendum with Moring Disposal the increase the recycling charge to \$0.30 per household starting on July 1, 2022.</li> </ul>	Recycling Program to start up on July 1, 2022.
