The Routing/Crack Filling had a tie for the lowest bid. We will be doing a coin toss to break the tie, Corey will contact the two contractors and see if they want to be present on Friday, March 11, 2022 at 9:30 a.m. Working on the easements for the Dixon Avenue project 	
6. New Business	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 3rd Avenue Street Reconstruction bids were opened on February 28, 2022. Low bidder was Twin City Construction in the amount of \$1,201,177.00. City Administrator Blackert stated that we were going to go ahead and get this project moving forward, the grant application for the project has been at the State for 21 months and we still have not heard if we have received the grant or not. If we do get awarded the grant we will apply for a change of scope in order to use it for another project. Motion was made by Alderman McKanna and second by Alderman Dowd to accept the bid from Twin City Construction and send to City Council for approval and award. 3 ayes, motion approved. The Routing and Crack Filling bids were opened on February 28, 2022. Denler, Inc. from Joliet, IL and National Industrial Maintenance, East Chicago, IN tied for the low bid in the amount of \$1.89 per pound. A motion was made by Alderman McKanna and second by Alderman Dowd to have to tie breaking coin flip on March 11, 2022 at 9:30 a.m. and forward the winner to City Council for approval and award. 3 ayes, motion approved. The Sidewalk, Curb and Gutter bids were opened on February 28, 2022. Low bidder was Porter Brothers Construction.
