Web Site Update:

Visitnorthwestillinois.com - In the last month we've had 11,990 unique visits to our website (up 86% over last month) and they viewed 1.73 pages per session. 10.66% came as direct traffic (typed in our URL); 40.37% came as organic traffic (searched using keywords that lead them to our site) and 32.53% were referrals and of those referrals 99.45% came from our Facebook posts. There were also 3,518 click thru's to the website from our online advertising spots.

The top landing pages were (1) Discover the Great Outdoors (this was a QR code link from our online ads) (2) Travel blog on the Forest Inn Restaurant (3) Travel blog on Patchwork Inn B&B (4) What to Do/White Pines

Advertising, Promotion & Public Relations:

- Our **Spring online advertising campaign** went live March 1st and it's doing **great** so far. Chad Blair, our TDG ad rep, sent the following analysis of the 1st month of the campaign:
 - Served over 380,000 impressions between Google, YouTube and Facebook in March
 - Generated over 6,400 clicks on our ads.
 - We saw an additional 9,200 engagements on the YouTube video ads.
 - 88 total conversions (request for more information and/or Visitor Guide)
 - Looking at analytics, we see significant gains in this year compared to last year.
- Print ads that have come out in the last month include *Spring-Summer Illinois Travel Guide* and the *Rock River Getaway Guide*. The *Silent Sports* magazine ad just came out & the web ad started April 1st and a banner ad on *windycitytimes.com* will run April 1-20.
- **Requests for information:** In the last month we had 394 requests for VG's from our website.
- **Social Media/blog report:** In the last month Jayne posted 20 times on all our social media channels.
