The Storm Sewer is going in on Dixon Avenue Administrator Blackert stated that the Avenue A engineering is 90% complete, 11th Street Bridge will be bid out in April 2024, we have not received the grant agreement for Avenue A yet so there is no time frame for bidding or starting the project.
