

There were 31 advertisements sold which brought the total overall cost down to \$5,338.00. Flock to the Rock had around 200 attendees and has already booked an ice carver for 2024 Flock to the Rock. Had a table at the Rock Falls Chamber meet-up. Rock Falls Tourism handed out information on sponsorships and upcoming events. The fiscal year Budget for 2024 is finalized. Sponsorship 2023 will be ending on April 15th Bands are booked for the Bellson Music Fest. Walfredo Reyes, Jr. will be doing the drum clinic. Jammin' on the Rock, the musicians and food spots are filled. Eats 'N' Beats needs business vendors, food spots are filled. Musicians are booked. The Vietnam Traveling Memorial Wall has been having monthly meetings. The wall will be escorted to the RB&W District on Thursday, August 31st at 10 am. The opening ceremony will be Friday, September 1st at 6 pm. The closing ceremony will be Sunday, September 3rd at 4 pm. Art in the Park has had 5 sculpture admissions and the band is booked.
