4.	Residential Solid Waste, Yard Waste and Recycling Collection and Disposal Update	• Derek Humphrey from Midwest Disposal updated the Committee on the progress with the Garbage Contract. There will be one truck for Rock Falls, garbage will be picked up every week and recycling will be picked up every two weeks. There will be a separate yard waste truck every week (seasonally). They are working on the plumbing at the RB&W Park Bathroom build and will be getting an updated time frame for completion.	No Action
