Updates	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Updates from Matthew Lenox from the Blackhawk Waterways CVB. Passed out the Illinois State Executive Summary to view. 2024 Visitor Guide is in drafting process now and hope to have distribution March 1st. Director Sam Smith from Rock Falls Chamber reported about their upcoming Rock Falls Chamber Dinner & Community Award Celebration which will be February 22, 2024. All invited. <p>Director Jones reported on Tourism updates:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dawn of the Decorations Halloween House Decorating Contest was a success with even more houses entering. Awarded for Most Scariest and Best Theme. Tour of Lights House Decorating Contest was a success with more houses entering. Awarded for Best Theme, Best use of Lights and Most Extravagant. Holiday Light Display @ Centennial Park – Approximately 2,226 cars went through and donations were about \$7,800 up from \$4,500 the previous year. Six more spaces were added this year and no problem filling them. The Coloma Township Park District plans to add 7-10 more spots for 2024. Boss Roofing-Siding Experts won the Most Popular Holiday Light Display this year. Voting was done via Survey Monkey on Facebook and also voting here at City Hall. Kayak Rentals started June 15, 2023 and ended for the season the first of November. It generated 64 rentals for a total of \$1,701 of which we get 50% of that equaling \$850.91. We feel it was a great success with people from out of town renting the kayaks to go on the Hennepin Canal. Bike Rentals May through October generated 99 total rentals for a total of \$440. This is an increase from 2022. Sponsorship Campaign is going on now. Packets were sent out beginning of December 2023. Flock to the Rock '24 – February 10, 2024. The Visit Rock Falls Website year to date has had 27.6K visitors with top sites being Calendar of Events, Things to Do, Vietnam Traveling Memorial Wall, Holiday Light Display @ Centennial Park and Visitor Guide. Committee Member Items	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Tom Henry from the Coloma Park District reported that he will be hiring the same horse wagon company that he had this year for next year's Holiday Light Display @ Centennial Park. Tom stated his board was very happy with the donations that came in for the 2023 Holiday Light Display @ Centennial Park and thanked Director Jones for all her help. Administrator Blackert reported that the restroom/utility building at RB&W District will begin as soon as March and is forecasted to be complete by the time of the Bellson Music Fest. Also, Gensini will finish caps on the pillars on amphitheater stage, redo front of stage and add stars that were from the Limestone Building, fix drainage on the north river walk and add concrete bollards to keep cars off that side of the walkway. Administrator Blackert reported that the limestone outcroppings have been placed in the berms at the RB&W District by Larry McCormick. Larry McCormick donated and planted more trees and shrubbery around the RB&W District. Director Jones reported that the Rock Falls American Legion would like to hold their Memorial Day Ceremony at the RB&W District and spread the ashes from the flowers and flags that were left at the Vietnam Traveling Memorial Wall over the ground of which the Wall sat.
