## 3. Old Business

# a. Request for Sesquicentennial prize basket – Rock Falls Chamber of Commerce

A Longaberger Basket has been received from Betty Clementz. The basket will be one of the prizes at the Chamber of Commerce Bingo. It includes a cutting board cover, and insert. The group thinks this location is good, and thanks Mr. Barajas for the offer.

#### 4. Marketing discussion
