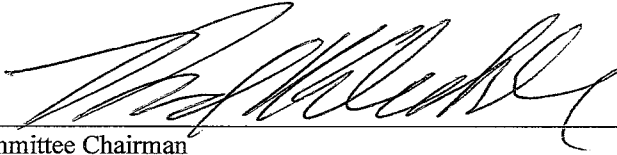

Topic	Discussion	Plan of Action
1. Call to Order	Chairman Kleckler called the meeting to order with a quorum present at 8:15 a.m.

3. Minutes	Review of the February 5, 2021 Public Works/Public Property minutes as presented. Motion: Wangelin; second: Palmer motion approved.	Minutes approved
4. Old Business	- E 11th Street Bridge – The City met with IDOT on the height of the new bridge and the access to the path. There should be no issues meeting the requirements. There is a possibility of partnering with the IDNR on this project, they will not be financially liable but once the engineering is complete there should be no changes that need to be made. Construction will not start until the 2024 construction year. 3rd Avenue Rebuild – Waiting on the State of Illinois on the decisions for the Rebuild America Grants. The City was notified that they will be making the decision on March 17, 2021. - Dixon Ave Project – Has been through the first review, with FAU Route projects there are many reviews that need to be completed. - Limestone Building – Terracon has asked for information on how much fill it will take for the fill in. Terracon will begin to do the sampling on the dirt that is going to be used soon, once the testing on the samples are complete we will be placing out for bid. Sampling, fill in trucking and grading will be covered under the grant, not sure if the seeding or sodding will be covered. - We are moving forward on the fencing along First Avenue, there are 3 fencing companies that will be giving us bids on the cost. 5. New Business	- Avenue A – Street Department has been filling potholes on Avenue A, have completed from 5th Street to 10th Street. We are waiting to hear if we have received the grant that was submitted before we move forward on any major repairs. - Patching and Pothole – Street Department has been out filling potholes for the last 2 weeks - Sealcoating and crack filling – There will be \$50,000.00 put into the FY 2022 budget. Larry Spinka has a list of 6 roads that need crack filling. - Mowing Crew – We will be hiring summer help again this year for the mowing. Alderman Kleckler asked if they need a trailer to haul the mowers. Larry Spinka stated that they had a trailer that they could use if they needed to transport the mowers. - Story Book Trails Signs – The signs at Industrial Park road have been removed and put into storage.
