Engineer's Report	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Corey Buck, Willett Hofmann & Associates gave an update on the 11th Street Bridge Project, all of the demolition and removal is complete. The Micro project is moving forward the parking lot is being striped and the path and sidewalk are being poured. 	No action on any items.
Street Department	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Update on the Concrete Contract for 2026 – we have \$60,000.00 in the FY 2027 budget for concrete work. Dave Miller will be giving them a list so they can look at what needs to be completed. Dave Miller stated that the Vitalytics contract was in the FY 2027 budget and requested that it be sent to the City Council for approval. Dave Miller stated that he is still working on getting the price for a Skid Loader set and the financing completed. Would like to have the City Council approve the purchase not to exceed \$96,346.00. They are discussing that the south wall will be Vietnam Vets and the north wall will be simple military seals. Once we have a drawing and cost of the murals we will be able to start on the funding. Mayor Kleckler asked about road repairs from street cuts for sewer and water. Dave Miller stated that if we have a bad road that will be worked on in the future that it doesn't make sense to do the same type of patch that we would on a good road.
