Residential Solid Waste Update	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Administrator Blackert stated that the change in solid waste haulers is going better than expected. 	No Action
New Business	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Committee reviewed the Chip Seal and Overlay bid tabulation sheets. Civil Constructors was the low bidder on both. Chip Seal bid was \$101,869.00 and the Overlay bid was \$166,767.20. Motion was made by Alderman Wangelin; second by Alderman Byrd to send the Chip Seal and Overlay bids to the City Council for approval. 3 ayes; motion carried. Street Department	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Street Superintendent Dave Miller stated that the crack sealing has been completed, they have been working on pot holes in the morning and will be using the Zipper for alley's and work on W 6th St and W 17th St. Update on last years Chip Seal – Not sure if fog seal is what we would want as the chip is not sticking to the road base. Brian Frickenstein suggested that we contact Porter Brothers to see if they have done any of the fog sealing in the past. Administrator Blackert stated that we need to let Porter Brothers try the fog seal, if it does not work we will need to look at taking further action. 	No Action
City Administrator, Robbin Blackert	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Administrator Blackert informed the Committee that the 11th Street bid letting should be in November 2025 with construction starting next year. We are working with Willett, Hofmann & Assoc. to get the joint agreement signed. We have contacted Martin & Co. regarding the blacktop on Avenue A. They need to do some dust control on the road if they are not going to get the blacktop completed very soon. We also are asking for a start date for the Micro Parking Lot. The bike path on Dixon Avenue has heaved, there should have been an expansion joint placed every 50 feet on the path, Willett, Hofmann & Assoc. are checking to make sure the specs were followed.
