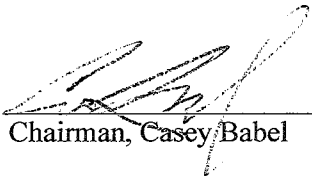

Web Site Update:

- In the last month we've had 21,059 unique visits to our website and they viewed 1.80 pages per session.
- 9.65% came as direct traffic (typed in our URL)
- 24.98% came via google ads/cpc
- 46.05% came as organic traffic via google search & keywords that clicked through to our site
- 16.22% were referrals and of those referrals 98% came from our Facebook posts.
- The top landing pages were (1) Discover the Great Outdoors via the QR code link from our online ads (2) Events/Wings Over Whiteside (3) Camping (4) Events/Morrison Shuckfest (5) Shopping /Antiques/Frank Fritz Finds

- We participated in the **Illinois Office of Tourism co-op online advertising campaign during May, June & part of July.** IOT matched 100% of each participating CVB's investment in an online advertising campaign that was done to build awareness of Illinois as a travel destination. It targeted a core audience of Illinois residents and border states, specifically in the St. Louis, Indianapolis and Milwaukee markets in the 35-54 age group with a household income of \$100-\$150k.
