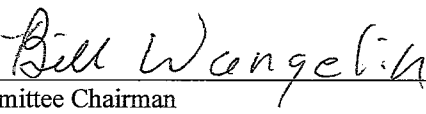

1. Call to Order	Chairman Wangelin called the meeting to order with a quorum present at 8:15 a.m.	
2. Minutes	Review of the November 4, 2021 Public Works/Public Property minutes as presented. Motion was made by Alderman Wangelin; second by Alderman McKanna. 2 ayes, motion approved.	Minutes approved
3. Engineer Report	- Corey Buck, Willett, Hofmann & Associates informed the Committee that the Limestone site fill is complete. The top soil and hydroseeding is the only things left to do and project should be complete in the next week. City Administrator Blackert stated that we signed a change order for a new completion date of December 14, 2021. - The Dixon Avenue project will possibly be let by June 2022 with project starting in August 2022. New Business	- Discussion on 3 vehicles that Firehouse Ministries are interested in. 2007 Ford Explorer and 2008 Ford Expedition which were used by the Fire Department and a 2007 Toyota Highlander that was used by the Building Department. 6. Old Business	Discussion on City Recycling Program. City Administrator Blackert and Mayor Kleckler have both talked with Steve Moring regarding the price increase if we start up the recycling program again in April 2022. Steve Moring has stated that he can't give a price because he doesn't know what the market will be doing in April. There will hopefully be more information in the next month or so regarding the cost. The Recycling Center will only be open one Saturday a month during the winter months. There are still problems with after hours dumping so we may need to add more signs and have the police do more patrols. Mayor Kleckler will be talking with the City of Sterling and the Townships to see if there would be any interest in a Regional Recycling Center. • Administrator Blackert stated that the downtown cameras are ordered and we are waiting on the fiber to be installed. Possibly the cameras will be up and running by Spring 2022.
