City Engineer, Corey Buck	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Corey Buck informed the committee that the Mico Parking Lots have been paved. 	
New Business	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Construction Observation Engineering Agreement with Willett, Hofmann & Associates for construction of the 11th Street Bridge – Administrator Blackert asked that this be pulled from the agenda as there are still questions that need to be answered by Willett, Hoffman & Associates. Street Department	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Street Superintendent Dave Miller stated that IDOT will be redoing the ASA structures along 1st Avenue. IDOT is now talking of putting a multi-use path along 1st Avenue from W 1st Street to Route 30 and on the north side of Route 30. A few alleys were missed during the snow plowing, the list is being updated to include these alleys. Looking at adding another V-Plow, these plows make alleys and clearing snow much easier to do. Cost of these plows are approximately \$10,400.00. 	No action on any items.
City Administrator	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The bid for the 11th Street Bridge Construction came in \$100,000.00 under the estimate, this will be a spring build. All easements have been granted for the Micro Grant project and the IDNR has issued the permit for the sidewalk under the bridge to the park. The Avenue A Grant has been audited and there were no findings, the closeout for the grant is coming. 	
Committee Member Items	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Alderman Doane gave an update on the murals that he has been working on. He has been in contact with the American Legion and they are receptive to having a mural on their building. He is also looking at the Veteran's Park and the Firehouse Museum building. Mayor Kleckler stated that he had been informed that the VFW has closed their doors, if anyone knows of a business looking for a building to let him know.
